1. Welcoming remarks: Agenda Review Welcome Steven Mace, TOPMB Chair

Steve Mace was introduced as TOPMB Chair. Steve shared the Ordinance Governing the Operations of the Town-Owned Property Management Board and explained the scope of the committee.

A. The budget was discussed as the Recreation Committee Budget was transferred to the TOPMB in October 2021 as per Steven Mace. The mowing is about \$1500 per year and the Electric bill at the Tennis court is about \$20 per month. This is being paid for by the TOPMB.

B. Skating Pond: Is the TOPMB responsible for clearing the skating pond in the winter? No, in the winter the Board only supports emergency situations. This would not be an Emergency situation.

C. Does the TOPMB have a snow blower? No.

D. Gary Pankey has volunteered to oversee the tennis courts since Paul has resigned. This will include keeping up with the trash as needed.

E. Suggested signage for the area: Respect and Enjoy Town Property or Carry In- Carry Out

For final clarification, the TOPMB is responsible for the permanent structures such as the basketball hoop, tennis net support and blacktop. Where the Recreation Committee focuses on the temporary equipment such as tennis balls, events and programming.
